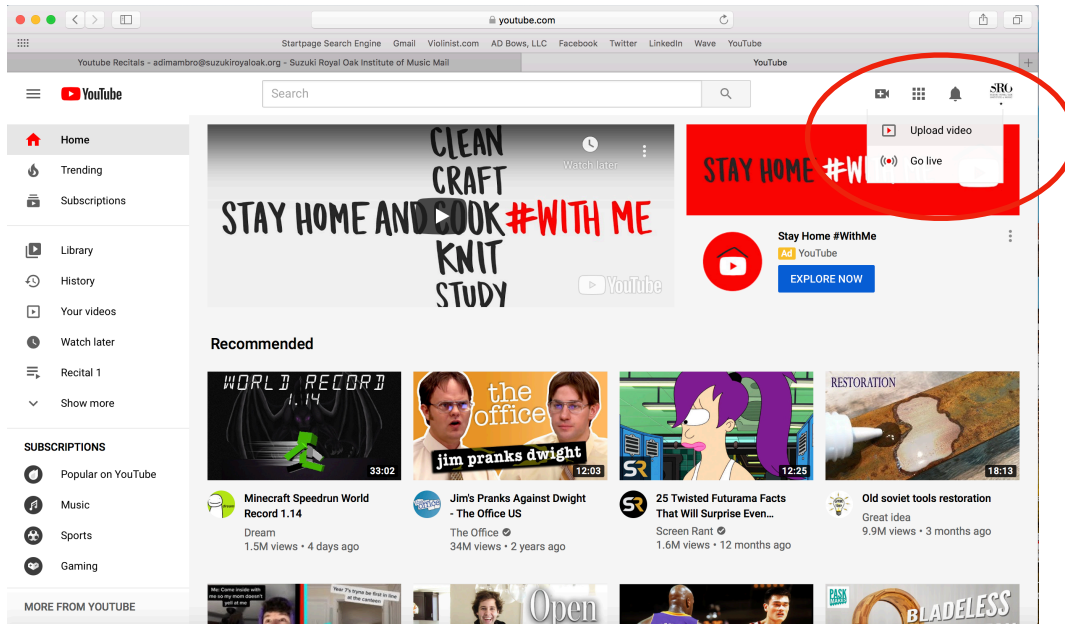
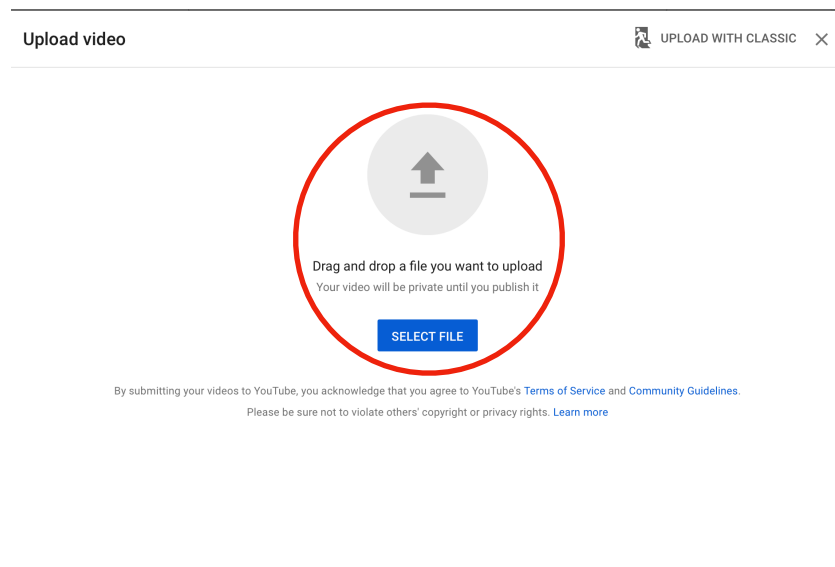


# Uploading to YouTube

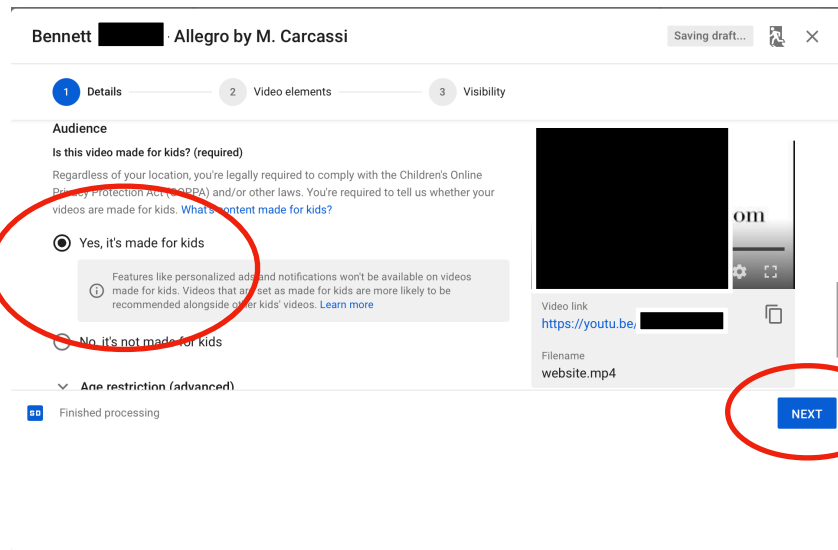

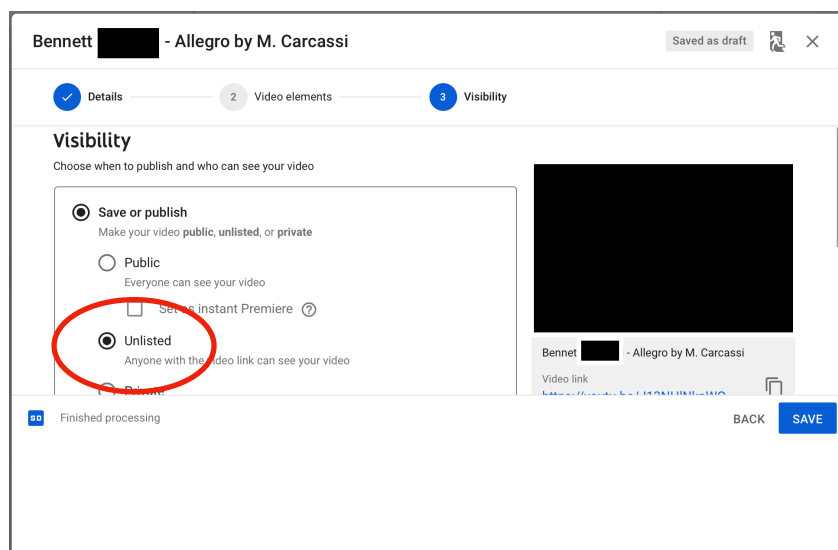

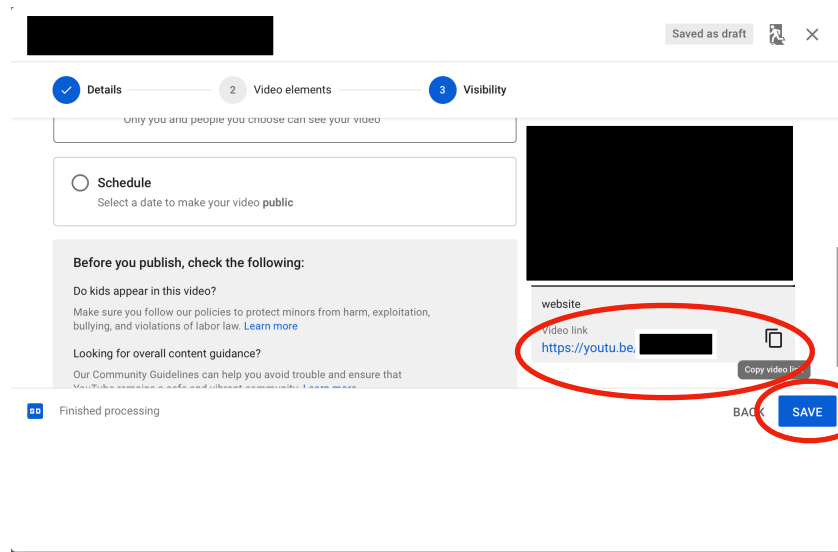
Scroll down and select “**Yes, it’s made for kids**”, this needs to be selected because we have children in our videos.
